



PILGRIMAGE TO ISRAEL, THE HOLY LAND

LED BY MINISTER TERRY JONES

FEBRUARY 19-27, 2010

Day 1

Depart CLE on our way to Tel Aviv Israel.

Day 2

Arrive at Ben-Gurion airport where our representative greets you and gives you an introduction about

the forthcoming trip in the Holy Land. Drive via the Coast to Caesarea Maritima where Paul was

imprisoned and Cornelius baptized, visit the Roman Theatre, Aqueduct and the Crusader ruins

Proceed to Galilee for the overnight stay on the shores of the Sea of Galilee.

Day 3

Today we tour the Sea of Galilee. Walk along the Jordan River and renew your baptismal promises.

Later visit Capernaum and Simon Peter's House, the Mount of the Beatitudes and Tabgha - the site of

the feeding of the multitudes. Take a boat ride across the Sea of Galilee and enjoy a St. Peter's fish

lunch in Tiberias. Back to our hotel for the overnight stay.

Day 4

This morning we drive through the village of Cana, the site of Jesus' first miracle and continue to

Nazareth – site of Annunciation and home of Mary and Joseph. Afternoon visit the Golan Heights -

Caesarea Phillipi where Peter identified Jesus as the Messiah. Return to Tiberias for the overnight

stay.

Day 5

Drive to Mt. Carmel, where Elijah confronted the Pagan prophets. Continue along the Coast . Ascend

the Jerusalem mountains yet before entering the Holy City, visit Bethlehem - the Birth place ! and the Shepherd's Fields. Possible visit to Bethlehem. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 6

Today we start our journey of faith in the Holy City. We shall visit view and experience Mount of Olives; Garden of Gethsemane; Mt Zion; the upper room and the Tomb of David; the Garden Tomb; the room of the Last Supper; Church of Peter in Gallicantu – marking the house of Caiphas and the site of the imprisonment of Jesus..

Day 7

Today we drive to Massada, site of the Jewish zealots' last stand against the Romans. Later, drive to Ein Gedi to experience the salty water of the Dead Sea. Continue our journey to the Qumran Caves, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Drive to Jaffa to enjoy our farewell dinner. Evening transfer to the airport for our night flight.

Day 8

Walk into the old city of Jerusalem. Experience the Christian, Jewish, Muslim and Armenian quarters. A special visit to the Temple Institute, where artifacts for the Temple are being created. See the Western Wall, the Temple ruins and the Temple Mount.. Later stroll through the colorful bazaars of the old city to the Pool of Bethesda. In the afternoon visit Yad Vashem – Holocaust Memorial.

Also visit recent excavations in the City of David and the pool of Siloam. End our day in Jaffa with our farewell dinner before driving to the airport on our way home

Day 9

Morning arrival back home.
